**Subtle** – A smooth-talking con artist, posing as an alchemist. Witty and manipulative.

**Face** – The cunning and charismatic housekeeper turned partner-in-crime. Versatile and quick-thinking.

**Dol Common** – The resourceful and sharp-witted accomplice who adopts various disguises to fool their victims.

**Dapper** – A simple-minded clerk who believes he can win big with a magical lucky charm.

**Abel Drugger** – An eager and bumbling tobacconist looking for alchemical help to succeed in business.

**Sir Epicure Mammon** – A flamboyant and gluttonous nobleman obsessed with the promise of boundless riches and pleasure.

**Tribulation Wholesome** – A zealous Anabaptist minister drawn into the schemes through greed.

**Ananias** – Tribulation's stern and fanatical deacon, eager to further their religious ambitions.

**Kastril** – A brash and quarrelsome young man hoping to learn the art of "quarreling" to defend his honor.
